
Removal

NOTE: Removal steps in this procedure may contain installation details.


Instrument panel antenna cable

NOTE: The original equipment AM/FM/satellite radio antenna cable(s) are part of the wiring harness and cannot be removed. This procedure refers to replacement of the cable(s) only by overlaying the cable(s).

1. Remove the FCDIM or FDIM.

2. Remove the screws, disconnect the electrical connectors and remove the ACM.
Torque: 27 lb.in (3 Nm)



3. Remove the RH A-pillar trim panel.

4. Disconnect the in-line connectors.




5. Remove the instrument panel upper section.

6. Remove the glove compartment.

Headliner antenna cable

7. Remove the headliner.

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8. **NOTE:** *Supercab headliner routing shown, all other routings similar.*


Remove the audio unit antenna cable.

1. Using tape, mark the audio unit antenna cable at the exit points for proper length from headliner-to-body/ roof connectors.
2. Carefully remove the audio unit antenna cable from the headliner.



Rear antenna cable


9. Remove the headliner.

10. Disconnect the electrical connectors, separate the cable guides and remove the rear audio unit antenna cable.




Installation

Instrument panel antenna cable

1. Cut the connector ends off the audio unit antenna cable.



2. Overlay using the routing shown and secure the new audio unit antenna cable to the instrument panel wiring harness, as necessary to prevent NVH concerns.



3. To install, reverse the removal procedure.


Headliner antenna cable

NOTE: Obtain the specified adhesive commercially. Depending on the headliner and audio unit antenna cable, the purchase of multiple tubes is suggested.

4. **NOTE:** Supercab headliner routing shown, all other routings similar.

Install the audio unit antenna cable onto the headliner.

1. Position the new audio unit antenna cable onto the headliner, making sure the cable has enough length to be connected to the body/ roof connectors at the tape location(s) applied earlier. Apply tape to temporarily hold the audio unit antenna cable in position on the headliner.
2. Apply the adhesive in the same location as the factory installed adhesive along the full length of the antenna cable-to-headliner to avoid any NVH concern(s).

5. To install, reverse the removal procedure.

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
