### Inspection

1. Inspect the front door-to-body dimensions.

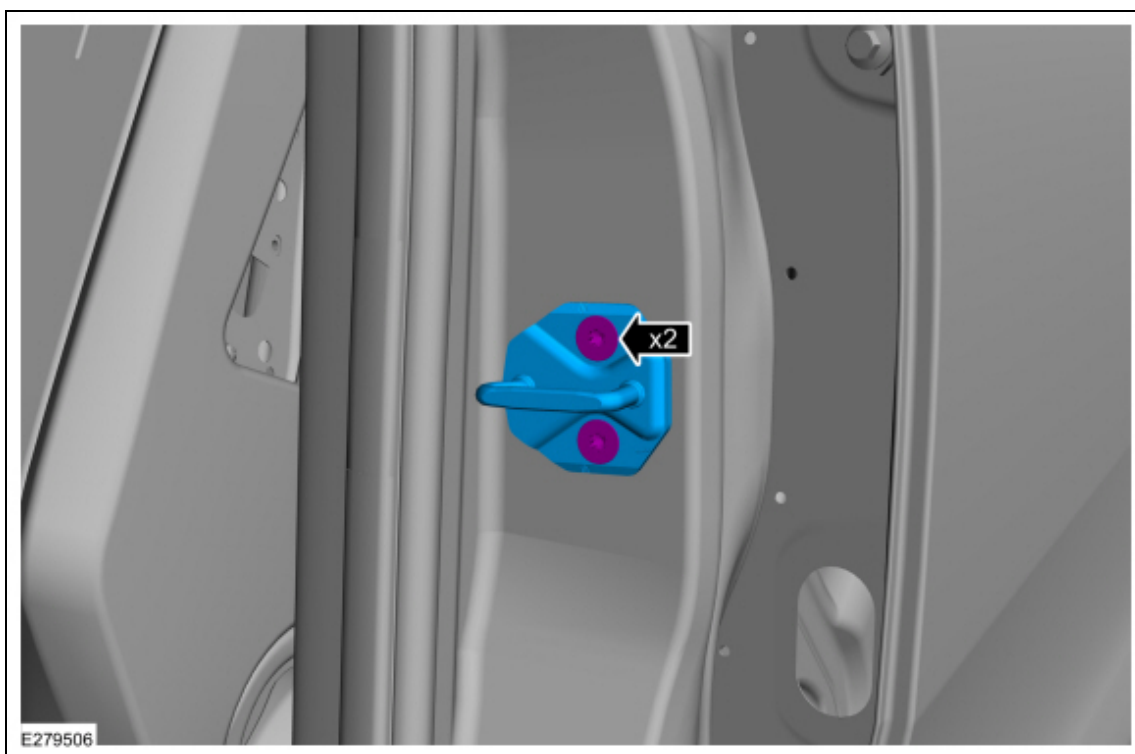
### Adjustment

#### All alignments

1. Open the front door.

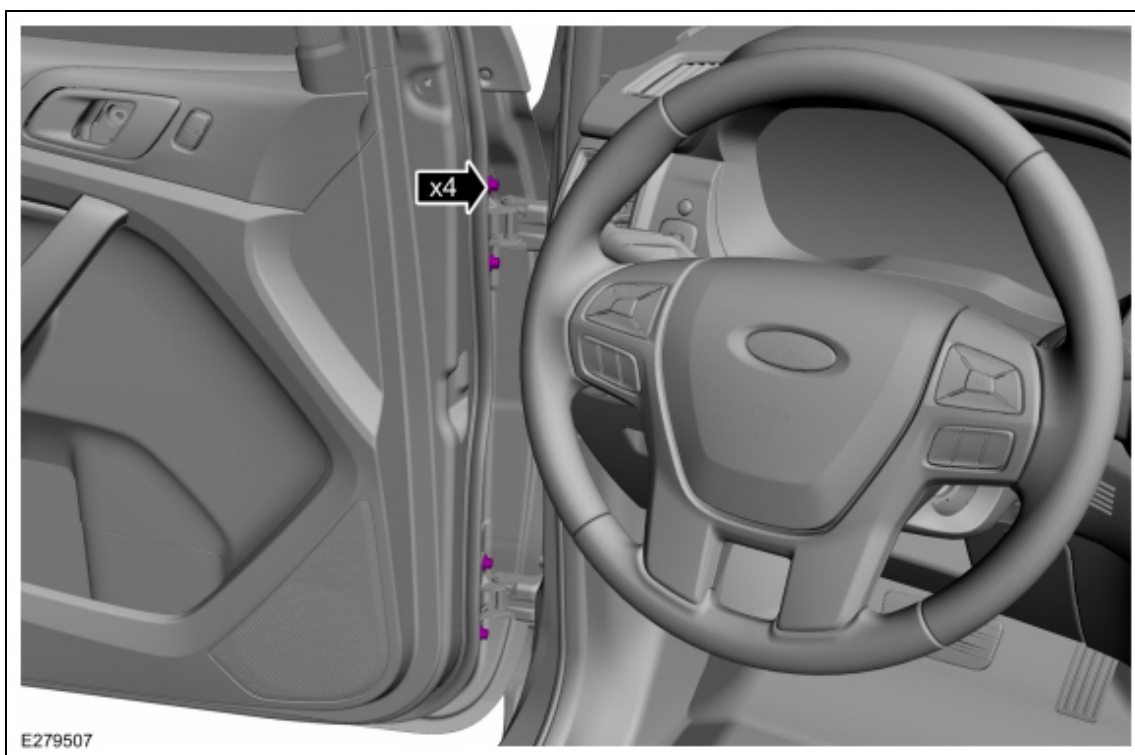


2. Remove the bolts and the striker assembly.

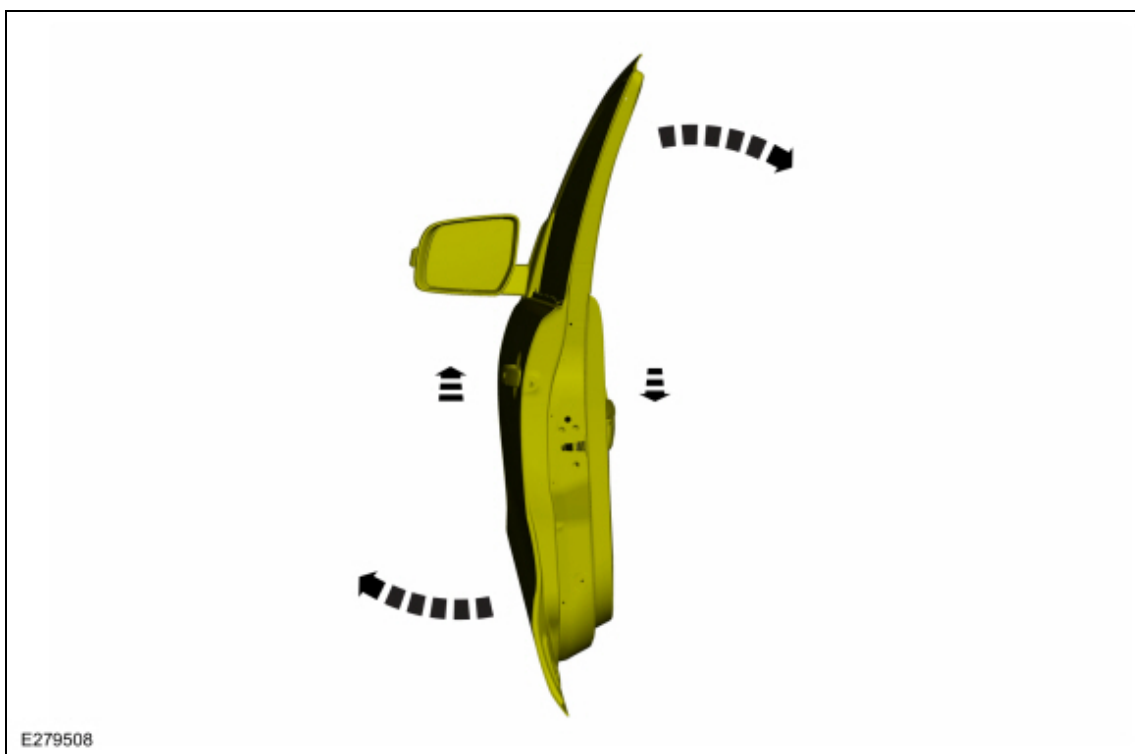


#### Front door in and out, up and down alignment

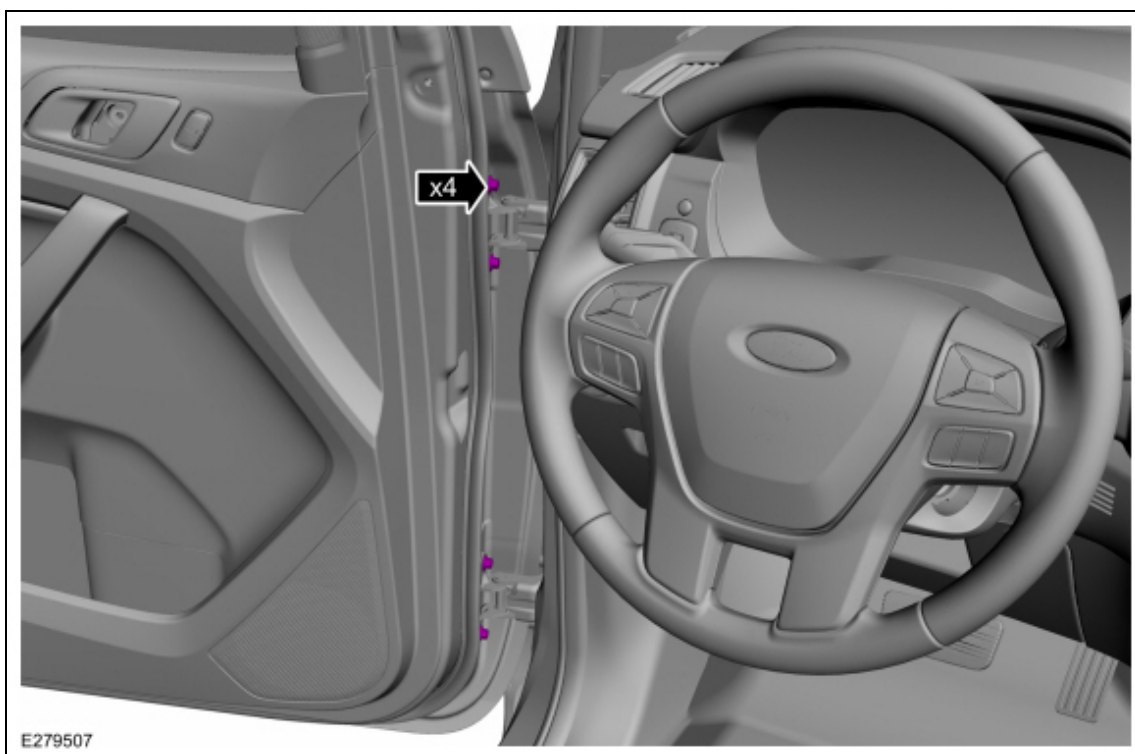
3. Loosen the bolts enough to permit movement of the door.



4. Adjust the door to specification.

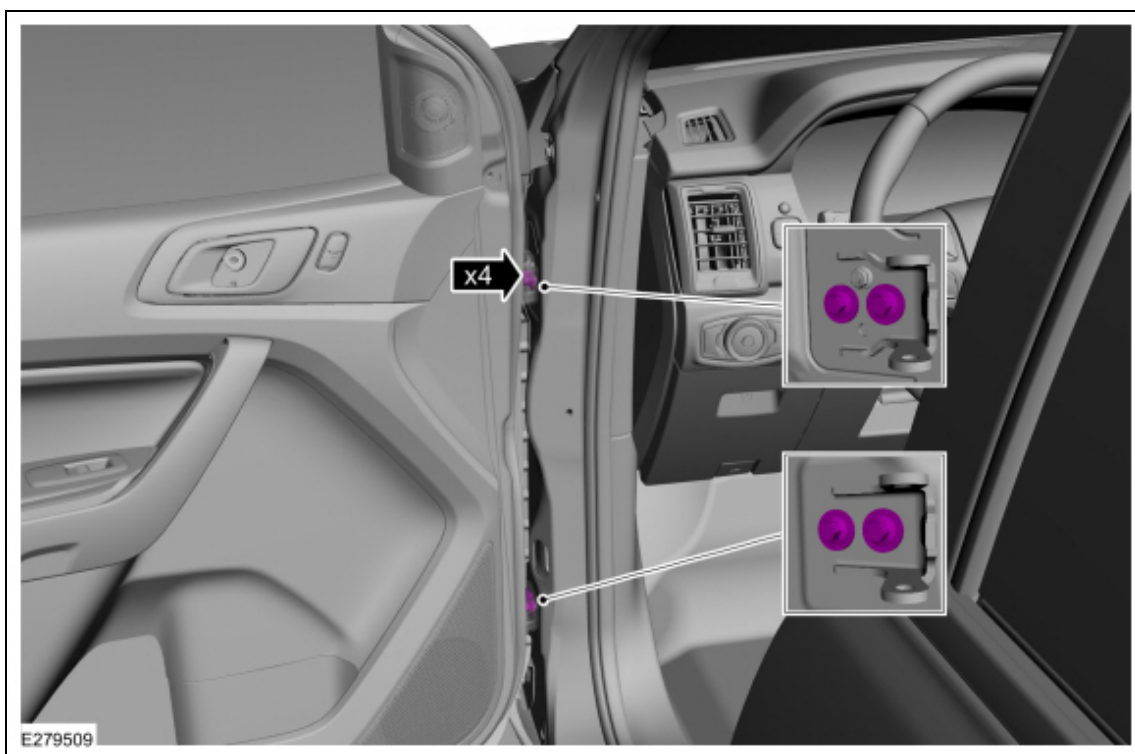


5. Tighten the bolts.  
Torque: 18 lb.ft (25 Nm)



#### Front door fore, aft and tilt alignment

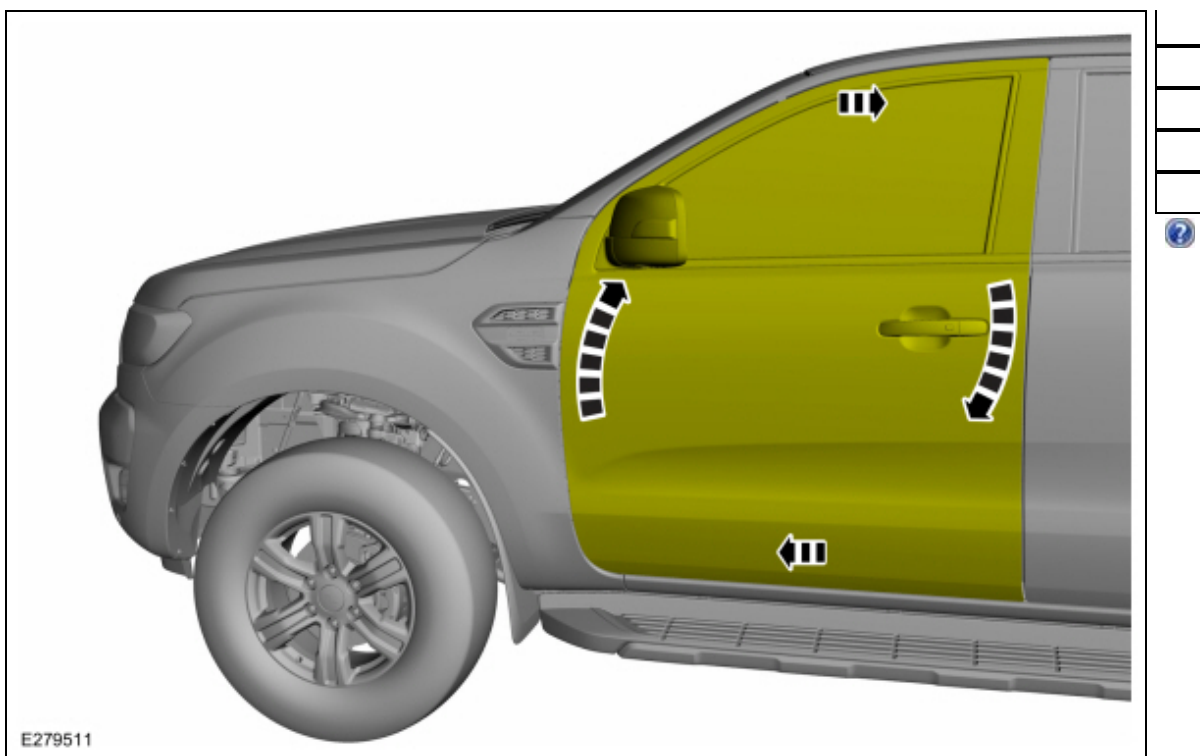
6. Loosen the bolts enough to permit movement of the door.



7. Carefully close the door.



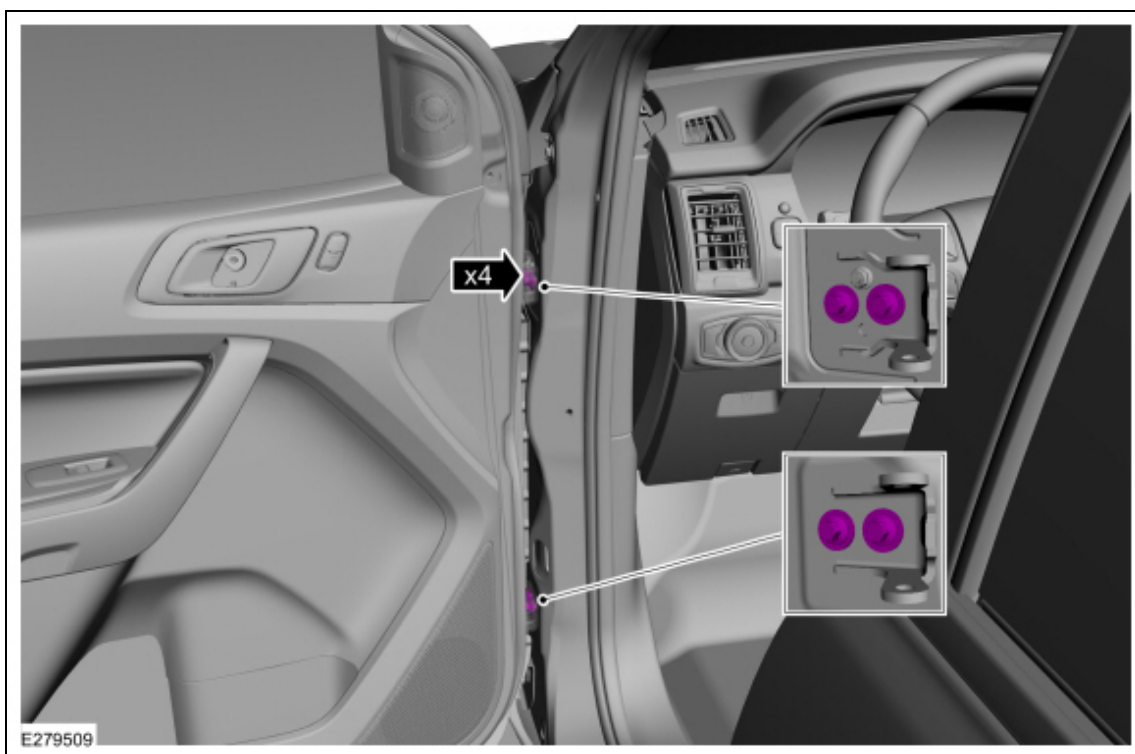
8. Adjust the door to specification.

9. Carefully open the door.

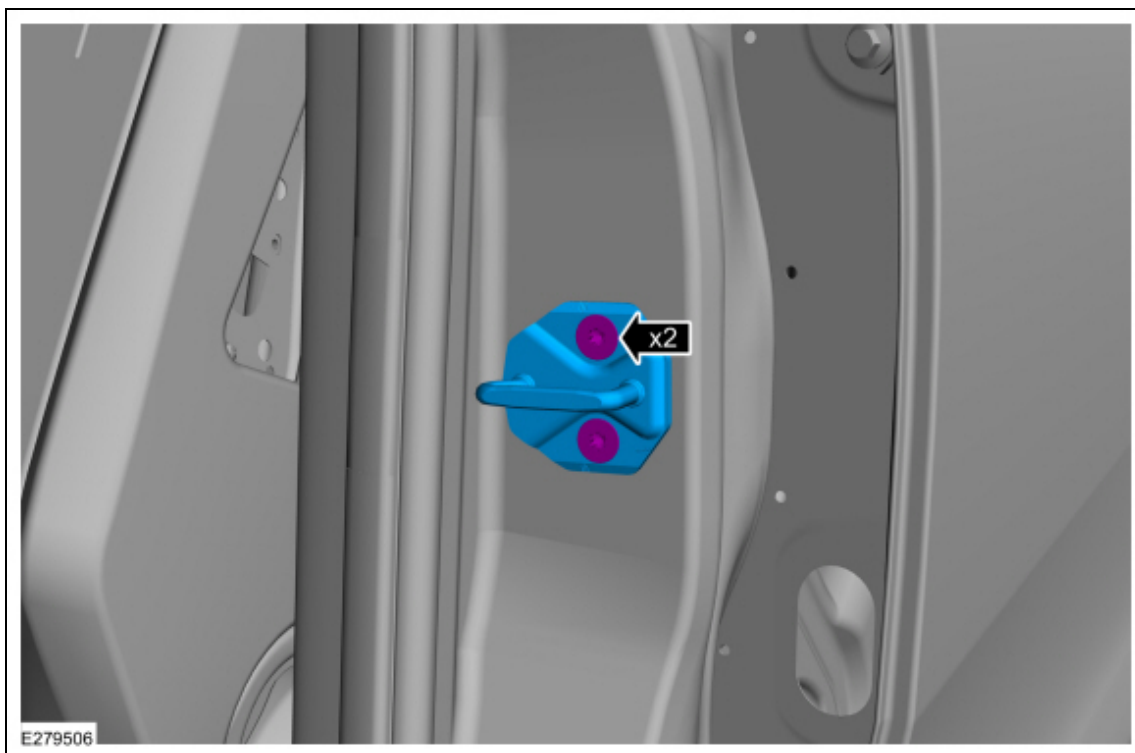


10. Tighten the bolts.  
*Torque: 18 lb.ft (25 Nm)*

Torque: 177 lb.in (20 Nm)
